Key Exam Information:

**Exam Board: GCSE Drama Pearson Edexcel**

**Assessment:**

**Component 1- Devised performance and portfolio 40%**

Year 11 students have already filmed their devised piece worth 15 marks.

They have already submitted their final 2000 word portfolio worth 45 marks.

**Component 2- Script performance 20%**

Students must perform two extracts from a script. This can either be filmed or an external examiner will come in to assess their performance This usually takes place between February to March (2026).

**Component 3- Final Exam 40%**

Written examination: 1 hour 45 minutes

60 marks

- Section A- Practical exploration and study of one complete performance text: 'An Inspector Calls'- 45 marks.
- Section B- Live theatre evaluation- 15 marks. Students can take in 500 words of notes.

**Course Overview:**

**September 2025- 24th November 2025**

Focus will be on the skills needed for the exam: 'Component 3: Theatre Makers in Practice'.

**November- March:**

I will be teaching the exam skills and knowledge needed for the Component 3 exam.

I will also be preparing the students for their Component 2 script performances. These will either be filmed or an external examiner will come in to assess the students' performances between February and March.

**March- May:**

I will be revisiting the exam skills, structure and knowledge needed for the Component 3 exam.

**Key content/ skills covered:**

**Component 2-**

Students will need to prepare for their script by knowing their lines and applying their performance skills. They will need to research their character's background and explore the Given Circumstances for the character. They will then be assessed on their performance skills by an external examiner.

### **Component 3 Exam- students need**

Students will need to revise key terminology for a performer, director, and a designer. They will need to revise the key plot points, characters and context in 'An Inspector Calls'. They will also need to prepare their notes for Section B: Live Theatre Evaluation in class and ensure they revise those notes before the exam. They will also need to practise their analysis skills and application of the different performance and design elements by completing exam responses at home in the time frames. Students can find past papers on the Google Classroom. If students would like these printed off, please just ask Mrs Cooper.
