Assessment: *There are 2 papers for GCSE Religious Studies, sat on different dates. The topics/ lengths/ weighting of papers are below:*

PAPER 1: Christianity (25%) and Islam (25%) 1 hour 45 minutes

PAPER 2: Themes A: Relationships and families, **Themes B:** Religion and life, **Themes E:** Religion, Crime and Punishment & **Themes F:** Religion, Human rights and Social Justice. (50%) 1 hour and 45 minutes.

Course Overview:

At present we are studying Theme E, after Christmas we will move onto our final topics of Islam Beliefs and practices. Students completed christianity Beliefs and practices in year 10.

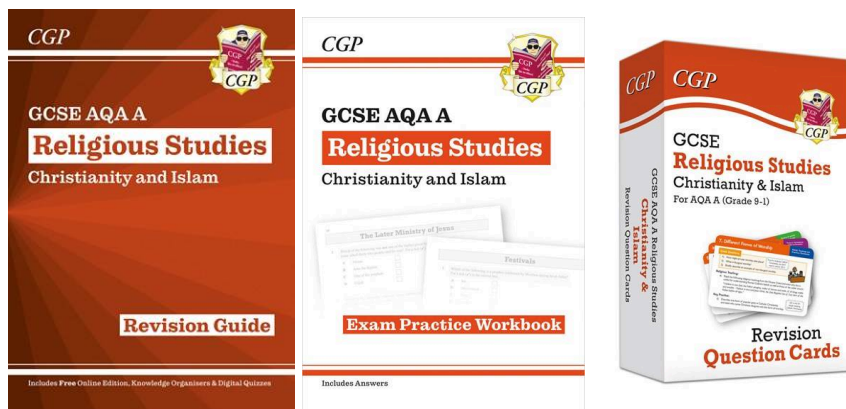
