1. Create a character profile for each character in J&H/ AIC – collect a range of quotes and analyse writer's methods;
2. Create a mind map of each of the key themes in J&H (fear, brutality and violence; secrecy and hidden worlds; duality and contrasts) / AIC (responsibility, power, older vs younger, class, gender). Include key quotes for each and explore writer's methods;
3. Choose one of the following statements and write an English Lang Paper 2, Question 5 (40 marks) style response:

'We are destroying the world we live in. We are wasting far too many of Earth's precious resources.'

'Young people today are sheltered from the realities of the world. They spend far too long locked away in their bedrooms.'

Write an article where you express your viewpoint on the above topics. Remember to spend 5-10 minutes planning your ideas first before writing up your clear argument.
